Hit R hip which shows a transcervical fracture NoF with minimal displacement Fascia Iliaca nerve block 40mls 0.25 bupivacaine with good result. ECG shows borderline first-degree heart block, Left axis deviation and RBBB. Admitted under trauma with cardiac review.</p>
