



Advisory Board actions and key messages 17 July 2019

This note provides a summary of the key information for sharing and actions for members arising from the 17 July Advisory Board. It is intended as an aide memoire for Advisory Board members and for onward distribution within your organisations as appropriate.

Funding

Our funding is under review as PRSB's sponsorship moves from NHS Digital to NHSX and negotiations have been delayed pending the launch of NHSX earlier this month. Discussions are now underway with NHSX but we are still waiting for new commissions and our work programme for 2019-20. **We need your support to emphasise the importance of PRSB as the voice of professionals and people who use services now that NHSX is taking the lead on digital transformation.**

PRSB strategy

We have refreshed our strategy and business plan which was developed following widespread consultation with members, the Board, clinical advisers and reflects the national drivers and strategic needs. **We ask that our member organisations and stakeholders sign off the [plan](#) and share any feedback with us.**

We have launched a campaign **#thedoctorsdownload** to better understand UK Doctor's digital experiences and insights with the Academy of Medical Royal Colleges, funded by Health Education England. ReSPECT

The ReSPECT process is a new approach to encourage people to have an individual plan to try to ensure that they get the right care and treatment in an anticipated future emergency in which they no longer have the capacity to make or express choices. The ReSPECT process has been fully implemented on the national digital platform in [Scotland](#) and has had some successful local implementation in England. ReSPECT was developed by the Resuscitation Council (UK) who led an extensive consultation. PRSB are to consider whether we formally assure and endorse the ReSPECT process. A consideration here would be a need for clarity between ReSPECT and other related standards e.g. End of Life standards, Co-ordinate my care etc. **Members views are welcomed, email us at info@theprsb.org.**
